History

Crystal Chapter #18 has a long rich history since its organization December 13, 1893, by Solomon Schmunk of Cleveland with 31 members. The charter was granted October 1894. Riddle Lodge #315 invited the newly formed Chapter to meet in its lodge room which was on the third floor of the Golding Building at the corner of Fifth and Washington Streets only about one block from its current location. The Golding Building was the first building in East Liverpool to have electricity. Over 200 attended the joint installation of officers with Riddle Lodge on January 17, 1894. In 1910 Crystal Chapter moved with the Masonic brothers to its Temple on Broadway in December 1910 where it still meets today. Crystal is the sixth oldest chapter in Ohio with Lorraine #1, Crescent #7, Mary #9, Grace #11 and Orion #12 being older.

In 1905 Crystal Chapter helped to institute Toronto Chapter #215. In 1911 Sarah Nichols an East Liverpool member suggested that Chester should have a chapter and she became the first worthy matron of Crescent Chapter #49. In 1919 another group formed a nucleus to institute a chapter in Wellsville which later merged back with Crystal in 2000.

Our current Crystal Club began as the Thimble Bee. It was organized in 1915 for members to meet in their homes. In the early days, they purchased a grand piano for the ballroom and during WWI adopted a French girl and sent her supplies. This group later became the Sunshine club and is our current Crystal Club.

In 1920 The Irondale Chapter was burned out, Crystal Chapter graciously offered the use of its chapter room.

In 1928 Carrie B. Hill was given a Life Membership and was named the Mother of Crystal Chapter. She was the first worthy matron and held the position for two years **.

In 1932 Worthy Matron Estella Hays and Worthy Patron Harold Jeanguenot had their officers wear formal gowns for the first time.

In 1934 Alta and Harold Jeanguenot were the first husband and wife team of worthy matron and worthy patron. Since then there have been twenty one teams of husband and wife in the east including our current Worthy Matron and Patron Grace and Keith McClester. . This is was also the first year that a registration committee was introduced.

In 1959 Jobs Daughter Bethel 61 was established at the temple with 170 girls being members.

In 1963 Sally Crawford and her father Charles Scott were the first daughter-father team to serve in the east. Since then there has been one more Colleen van Leeuwen and her father Earl Fitzgerald.

In 1971 the traveling jewels were purchased to be used by Worthy Matron and Worthy Patron Helen and Richard Kidder and were to be presented to each newly installed worthy matron and worthy patron at the time of installation. In 1973 Esther Dillion and William Underwood were the first sister brother team to serve in the East.

A few changes have been made since our 100th Anniversary, Crystal Chapter now meets in the Ball Room except for special occasions like installations, receptions, and inspections. Wellsville Chapter merged with Crystal in 2000.

Crystal has been honored with the following appointments in the last twenty-five years: Two Grand Officers: Deanna Plemons and Karen Jones. Drill Directors: Esther and John Calhoun. Two Deputy Grand Matrons: Mary Forbes and Mary Lou King. Three Grand Representatives: Sally Crawford, Esther Calhoun, and Bonnie Blevins. Five Grand Aides/Pages: Mary Forbes, Mary Lou King, Carol Monday, Ingrid Henthorne, and Tom Jones. Five District Presidents: Esther Calhoun, Marilyn Wagner, Sally Crawford, Karen Jones and Grace McClester. Three Charity Directors: Grace Hoffman, Mary Lou King and Colleen van Leeuwen.
